## **Why Engage with Global Mission at New Heart?**

A decision to participate in any kind of mission (short, medium or long term) is an important and life changing decision. We want to encourage and support those who are exploring whether overseas mission is for them and help to redirect people who have ministries more suitably expressed elsewhere, or for whom the timing is not yet right. We want our people to thrive and bear fruit that will last for the kingdom. In line with our vision and mission we will prioritise assignments that lead to disciple making.

**We need to ensure that missions is right for the person and that the person is right for missions.**

It must be recognised that mission activity may involve considerable risk. As we take seriously the commitment to see our congregation involved in mission we have a process that we believe those who are interested, either in long or short term mission, should follow. This will help us all to know that we are sending and supporting those whom God has called
